**Housewarming Baskets:** Help give our clients a little hope with a laundry basket filled with items like: a wastebasket, tissues, toilet paper, all-purpose cleaner, dishtowels, bath towels, toilet brush, sponges, hand soap, laundry detergent, and dish soap. The ideas are endless and the help is tremendous!

**Cell phones:** Sojourner accepts **ALL cell phones with or without accessories**. Phones in good shape can be used for 911 phones and even broken ones can be turned into cash for our programs through our partner Shelter Alliance.

### Clothing:

- **New Clothing** is accepted all year round. Casual clothing is especially needed for both women and children.
- **Used Clothing:** *Very gently* used clothing is accepted four times a year before each season. In-season clothes are accepted during the second week of August, November, April and June. Please call 952-351-4062 for details.
- **Sleepwear, underwear and accessories:** **\*All items must be new\*** All sizes from infant to women: pajamas, slippers, **women's underwear (esp. larger sizes)**, children's underwear (3t-12 and teen sizes), **socks for all, bras (including teen sizes and larger sizes), flip flops, robes, nightlights, alarm clocks**

### Personal Care and Health **\*Sojourner doesn't accept travel size items- all products must be new and full size\***

- **Personal Care Products:** **hair care products (especially for African American hair), shampoo, conditioner, bar soap, body wash, deodorant, Q-tips, lotion, feminine hygiene products, brushes and combs, hair ties, nail clippers, lip balm**
- **Healthcare Items** **\*ALL MEDICATION MUST BE ALCOHOL FREE\*:** **hand sanitizer, various sized band-aids, antibiotic ointment, digital thermometers, Children's Tylenol (fever reducer), children's cold medicine, Tylenol Allergy and/or Sinus, ibuprofen, Midol, Vicks Vapor Rub**

### Daily Shelter Needs

- **Cleaning Supplies:** window cleaner, soft scrub, **Lysol Disinfectant spray and wipes**, liquid floor cleaners, scouring pads, magic erasers, **dish soap, bleach**, kitchen towels, dish cloths, brooms and mops
- **Paper Products:** **tissues, paper towels, napkins, paper plates**, bowls and cups, **plastic silverware, toilet paper, Ziplock bags**
- **Linens:** twin sized sheet sets, **waterproof zippered twin sized mattress covers**, twin sized comforters and blankets, pillows, **bath towels**, washcloths, hand towels
- **Gift cards:** **local gas stations, Cub Foods, phone cards, Target, Kmart, bus tokens, Office supply stores**

### Child and Baby Care Items

- **Child Care Items:** **\*ALL ITEMS MUST BE NEW OR VERY GENTLY USED\*** Toys, NEW stuffed animals, children's movies, and learning toys (Leap Frog), Big toys for the playroom and playground
- **Baby Care:** Diapers and Pull-ups (especially size 3,4, and 5), Baby wipes, diaper rash ointment, teething rings, pacifiers, baby bottles and Sippy cups, bath wash, baby shampoo, **baby lotion**
